

Using a burkini at the swimming hall

The use of a burkini is allowed at our swimming hall, however, please follow the instructions below to ensure your own safety and common hygiene.

1. The swimsuit should be made of a material suitable for the swimming pool. The cloth shouldn't give off lint or other dirt into the pool water. Fabrics like cotton or acrylic are not suitable for swimming at a public pool.
2. The swimsuit shouldn't have pockets. The pockets can easily carry dirt and lint into the pool.
3. Underwear should not be worn under the swimsuit.
4. The swimsuit should be body-tight and the sleeves and legs should be tight because the loose fitting cloth can be trapped in the pool structures or be surprisingly heavy while swimming, posing a risk to you.
5. Put on the swimsuit at the swimming hall only after you have washed yourself in the shower. If using the showers with others while naked is an issue, there are separate showers available. Please consult staff when needed.
6. Do not wear a swimsuit when going to the sauna.
